## New injection wells needed

The U.S. Department of Energy-Savannah River (DOE-SR) Operations Office has requested from the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (SCDHEC) a modification to Savannah River Site's 1992 Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Part B Permit Renewal Application, Volume IV, which details operations at the F-Area Hazardous Waste Management Facility (HWMF), and Volume V, which details operations at the H-Area Hazardous Waste Management Facility (HWMF).

The revision requests (Rev. 9 for Volume IV and Rev. 10 for Volume V) are for new injection wells to

replace and/or augment existing wells that are not performing adequately. The new wells will allow remediation efforts to continue.

There will be a public meeting at the Aiken County Library April 22 from 3:00 to 5:00 p.m. Representatives from SRS will be available to answer questions.
