TEMPORARY AUTHORIZATION (TA) REQUEST TO DHEC FOR SAMPLING AND TREATMENT OF POTENTIALLY SHOCK SENSITIVE MATERIAL

On August 17, 2006, a one quart bottle of ethylene glycol monomethyl ether (CAS 109-86-4) was discovered in a drum of waste during routine sampling activities in building 645-N of the permitted hazardous waste storage facility at the Savannah River Site (SRS). SRS is requesting a Temporary Authorization (TA) pursuant to South Carolina Hazardous Waste Management (SCHWMR) R.61-79.270.42(e) to perform the movement of potentially shock sensitive container/s to a subcontractor high hazard team's trailer, sample the contents of the container/s and subsequent treatment by deactivation and/or neutralization. Following the sampling and any treatment the containers will be returned to a proper storage container within the permitted storage building within the shift.
