Wackenhut Services Incorporated – Savannah River Site Makes Temporary Request to Temporarily Treat Lead-Containing Tires

Wackenhut Services Incorporated - Savannah River Site (WSI-SRS) has requested from the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (SCDHEC) a temporary authorization request to temporarily treat lead-containing tires at the Tire Shoothouse.

This project will dismantle and remove the Tire Shoothouse. The Tire Shoothouse was constructed in 1984 and was used until 2002 for training the WSI-SRS Special Response Team (SRT). The structure was constructed of vertically stacked tires placed on steel poles, which were imbedded in a concrete footing and filled with sand. The tires that contain lead will be temporarily stored in a pile prior to being chopped into quarters and placed in proper containers for temporary storage prior to being shipped to an approved landfill for disposal.
