Permit Modification Requested for Transuranic Waste Storage Pads Facility

The Department of Energy (DOE)-Savannah River Operations Office has requested that the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (SCDHEC) modify Savannah River Site's (SRS) 2000 Resource Conservation and Recover Act (RCRA) Permit SC1 890 008 989. This modification requests the clarification of locations where TRU waste containers that contain or may contain small amounts of liquid may be stored or processed at the Transuranic Waste Storage Pads (TRU Pads) Facility.

This notice begins a 60 day public comment period. More information, including the actual permit application, is available for review and copying at the DOE Public Reading Room located in the University of South Carolina-Aiken Library, or may be obtained by contacting personnel identified in this notice. The Permittee's compliance history during the life of the permit being modified is available from SCDHEC.

A public meeting will be held on Monday, April 23 at 2 p.m. at the Aiken County Public Library. Representatives from SRS will be available to answer questions on the modifications. Written comments may be sent to SCDHEC. All comments will be considered in the final decision. Please send your comments to R. A.
