Draft Environmental Assessment (EA) Prepared for Biomass Cogeneration and Heating Facilities at SRS

DOE has prepared a draft EA to analyze the potential environmental consequences of the proposed construction and operation of the new biomass cogeneration and heating facilities at the Savannah River Site. The facilities would consist of two energy conservation measures; (1) a new biomass cogeneration facility to replace the existing coal-fired D Area powerhouse, and (2) two new biomass heating plants at K and L Areas, to replace the existing oil-fired K Area steam plant.

The public comment period for this draft EA will be open until July 7, 2008. Any comments received after that date will be considered to the extent practicable.
