Notice of Filing a Permit Application with the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control For the Savannah River Site's 288-F Landfill Expansion

The Department of Energy (DOE)-Savannah River Operations Office has filed a permit application with the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (SCDHEC) for modification of the Savannah River Site (SRS) 288-F solid waste landfill permit.

The landfill is located in F Area of SRS in Aiken County. The nearest town is Jackson, S.C., which is approximately five miles from the landfill. The proposed modification is a vertical expansion that will allow an additional 176,096 cubic yards of coal ash waste to be placed into the landfill. Ash is the only waste to be placed into this landfill.

The proposed landfill expansion is planned to accept approximately 2,500 tons of ash annually. The proposed life of the landfill is in excess of 20 years.
